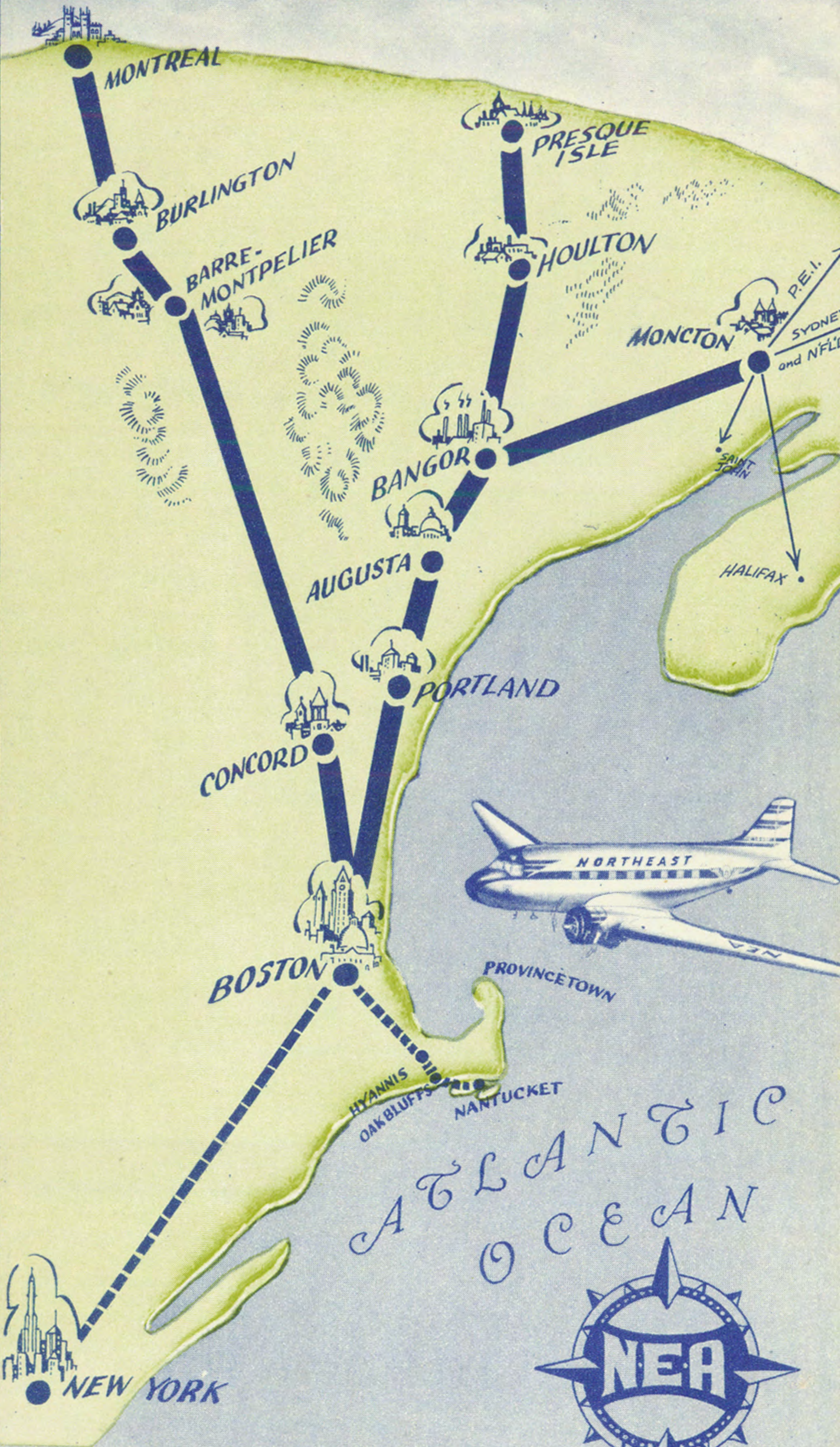

Carrying passengers on essential business, along with vital mail and express, is but a part of Northeast Airlines' war activities. In addition to the thousands of miles Northeast flies daily in commercial airline service between cities in New England and Eastern Canada, our crews also fly thousands of miles day and night over the North Atlantic under contract with the U. S. Army Air Transport Command.

Northeast, like other U. S. airlines, sent most of its fleet to war early in 1942. Since then, it has not always been possible for us to offer the excellence in passenger accommodations or the dependability in schedules characteristic of pre-war air travel, but there never has been any compromise with our high standards of maintenance and operations.

The return of a portion of our fleet by the government has made possible the resumption of the Boston-Montreal route. This will mean adequate air transportation for travelers between Boston and Montreal, as well as greater regularity in the operation of all NEA flights.

As soon as more flight equipment is available, Northeast will inaugurate frequent non-stop flights between Boston and New York, later serving the cities of Worcester and Waterbury on one route, and New Bedford on another. Northeast will also fly to Cape Cod, Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket. Direct Portland-New York service, via Lawrence and Worcester, will prove invaluable to the important industrial areas of the Merrimack Valley and central Massachusetts.

Northeast, New England's own airline, has other major post-war ambitions, all aimed to give the entire New England area the ultimate in air service. Until then, Northeast Airlines is doing everything within its power to speed the day of total victory.

TRAVEL BETWEEN CANADA AND THE U. S.

U. S. CITIZENS need only to carry birth certificates or other evidence certifying citizenship.

CANADIAN CITIZENS (born in and residing in Canada) may enter the U. S. for visits of 29 days or less upon presentation of birth certificate with a photograph of true bearer properly attached.

OTHER CANADIAN CITIZENS who hold valid passports may secure Border Crossing Identification Cards at Bangor Airport during regular plane stop by submitting 3 additional passport photographs. All Canadians must also secure Form H from local bank and, over 16 years old, must secure Labor Exit Permit or Exemption Certificate. Newfoundland travelers require passports and visas. Consult your travel agent or airline ticket office for details. Canadians are now allowed \$150.00 (plus air tickets purchased in Canada) for spending in the U. S. on pleasure or business—or \$75.00 for each of two trips in one year.
