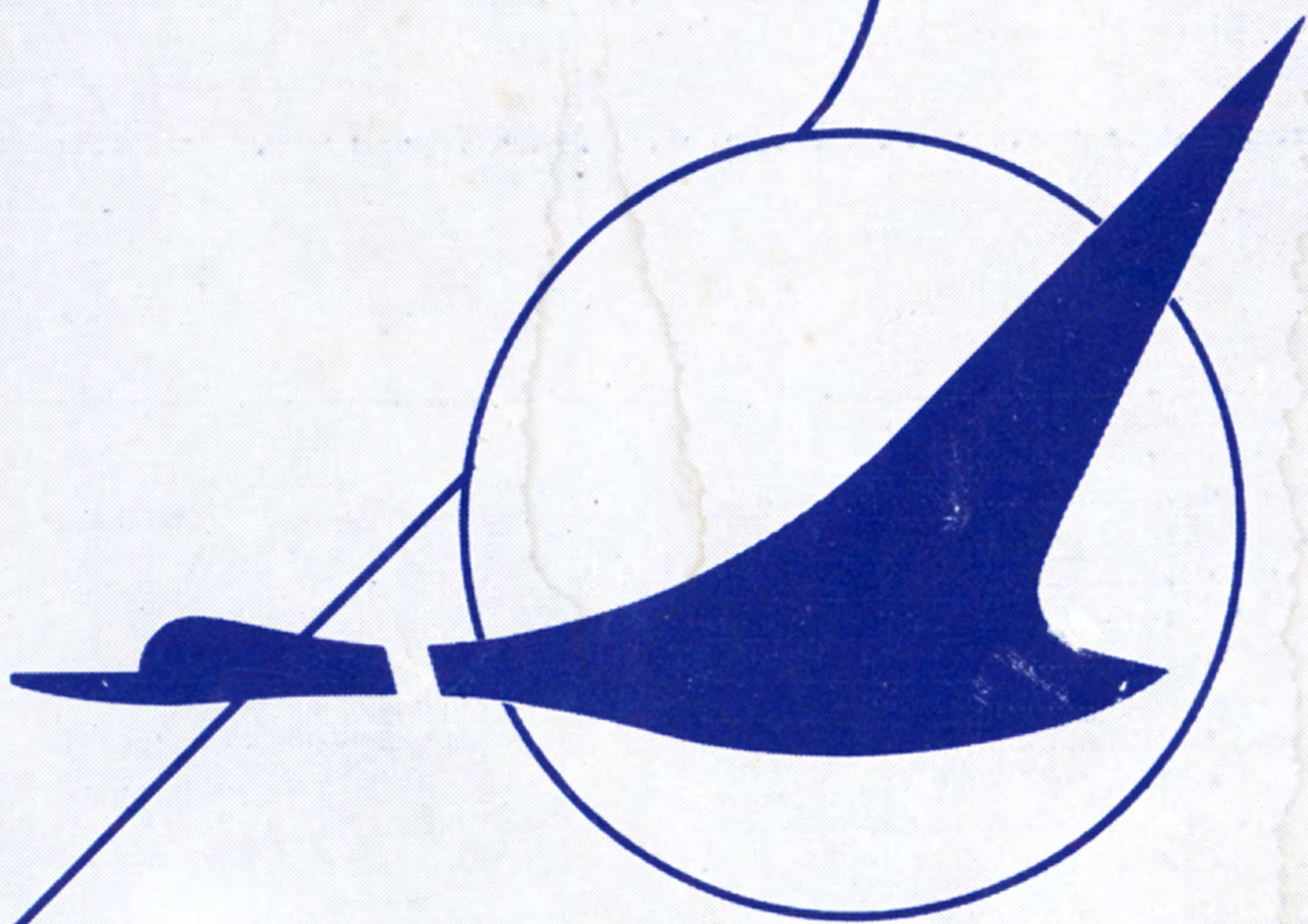

All passenger travel on airlines is arranged by making an advance reservation for your flight.

Air travel reservations — going and returning — are easily and quickly made, at no extra cost, through any scheduled airline ticket office. See your Classified Telephone Directory and phone any of the airlines listed — the airline representative will give you complete information on time of

flights — fares — tickets — and route you over the most advantageous airlines to your destination in the United States or abroad. If you prefer call in person at any airline office, the airline representative will be glad to plan your flight with you.

Reservations and information on air travel are available through more than 1800 travel agencies and 1500 airline offices located in the principal cities of the United States.

TO GET THE MOST FROM YOUR TRIP — SEE YOUR TRAVEL AGENT

Let your travel agent plan your trip. His services involve no extra cost and will save you time and effort. He will help you plan your itinerary and make all necessary reservations. Many individuals and organizations rely on their travel agent for all their needs in domestic and foreign transportation. Your travel agent can be very helpful, particularly

on international trips or travel overseas — providing complete and detailed information on countries abroad, passports, visas, customs procedures, hotel reservations — advice on places to visit, resorts, money, climate, clothing to take along. Your travel agent is an expert on travel — it pays to see him first.

THROUGH AIR SERVICE TO DESTINATION FROM ANY POINT ON THE WISCONSIN CENTRAL AIRLINES ROUTE

Wisconsin Central is a "feeder" airline with specialized facilities for making convenient connections with trunk airlines (national and international systems), makes reservations and issues tickets over all airlines of the United States and the world. As a member of the Air Traffic Conference of America, Wisconsin Central Airlines honors Universal Air Travel Script Cards.

Through the facilities of Wisconsin Central you can go by air *through* to your destination — in the United States or abroad.



PASSENGER INFORMATION

- **RESERVATIONS** must be made in advance. Passengers must present themselves at the airport office of Wisconsin Central Airlines at least ten minutes prior to plane departure time.
- **CANCELLATIONS:** Wisconsin Central reserves the right to cancel any booking before passage begins or enroute whenever such action is deemed advisable or necessary. In all events the passenger's sole recourse shall be the recovery of that portion of the fare equal to the distance untraveled.
- **BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE:** Forty pounds of baggage, including brief case and hand luggage, will be carried free on any ticket. Charge for excess baggage, up to fifty pounds, is 1/2 of 1 percent of the one way fare per pound, with a minimum charge of 25 cents.
- **CHILDREN'S FARES:** A child under two years of age will be carried free if held on lap. Children two years of age and under twelve will be charged one-half the applicable adult fare. Children under eight must be accompanied by an adult passenger.
- **SCHEDULES** show the time at which planes may be expected to arrive at, or depart from stations, but the Company will not be responsible for consequences arising from delays or from errors in the printed schedule. Schedules and fares shown are subject to change without notice.
- **STOPOVERS:** Within the time limit of the ticket, stopover will be permitted at any scheduled stop provided prior arrangements have been made. Passenger assumes responsibility of making necessary subsequent reservations.
- **CAB SERVICE:** For the convenience of passengers, Wisconsin Central will be glad to arrange taxi or bus transportation if notice is given ticket agent before departure of plane.

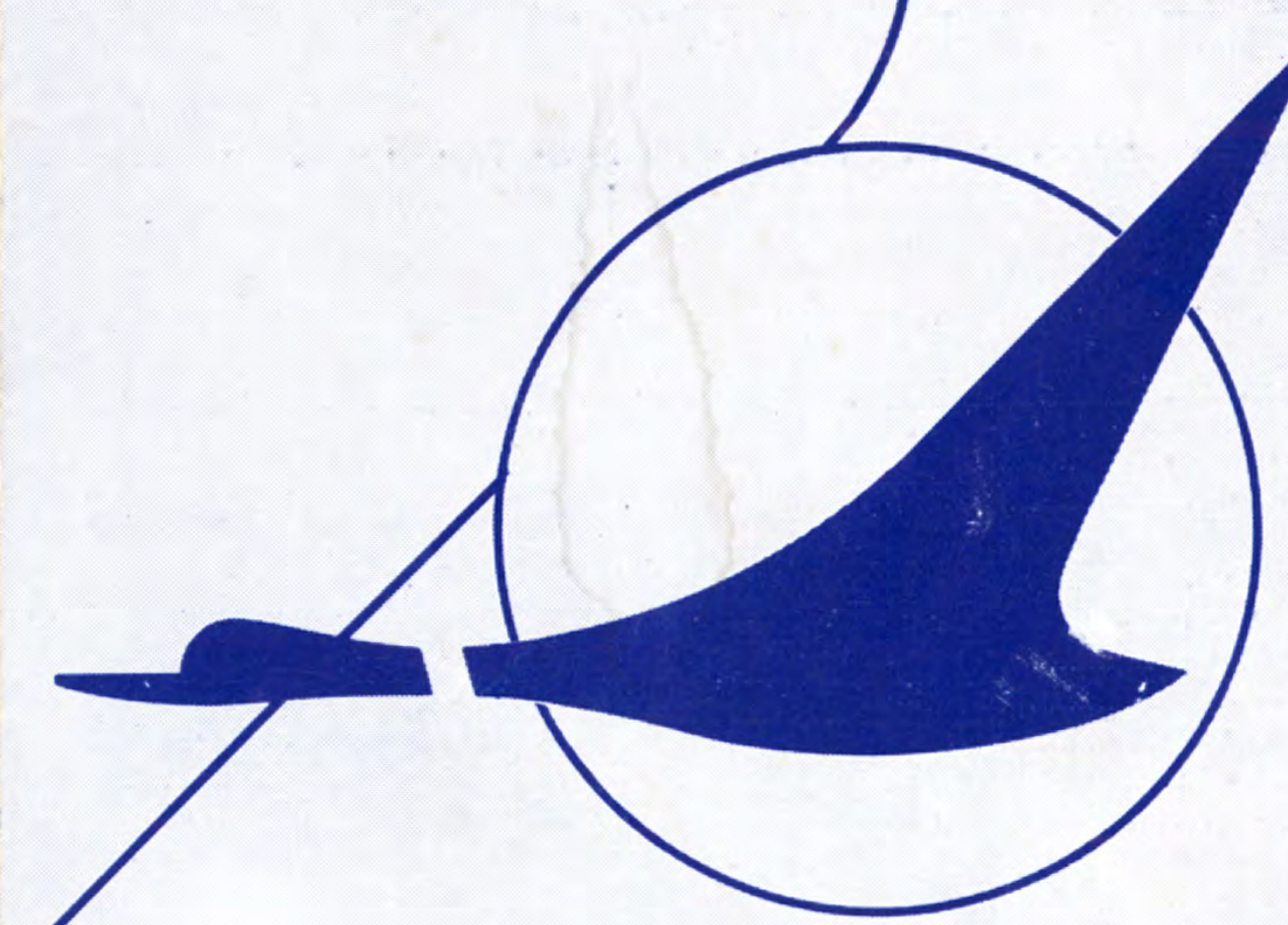

EQUIPMENT

Lockheed Electra twin engine transports are operated on all flights. These planes are especially adapted for regional type air service and have been proven on a number of airlines. The flight system provides daily round trip service to all points on the Wisconsin Central route.

IMPORTANT!

SIX HOUR RECONFIRMATION OF RESERVATIONS REQUIRED

Passengers holding confirmed space on Wisconsin Central Airlines should reconfirm their reservation at least six hours before scheduled departure time if—

1. Ticket is purchased at a station other than the station from which the passenger is boarding the plane.
2. Reservation is for the return trip of a round trip ticket.

Failure to communicate with the local Wisconsin Central office at least six hours prior to flight time may result in cancellation and resale of this space.

TEN MINUTE AIRPORT CHECK-IN TIME

If this ticket is not presented at the counter of our airport office at least ten minutes prior to scheduled departure time of your flight, the space held for you may be cancelled by us and sold to another passenger. Your cooperation is appreciated.
